



B.H. "DUFFY" BASS - Illinois State University, Normal

Duffy began his coaching with a nine year stint at University High School in Normal where his teams won 135 games. He moved on to Illinois State University where he served as head coach for 25 years amassing 713 victories. His teams were involved in 7 post-season tournaments highlighted by winning the NCAA College Division National Championship in 1969. Duffy was selected District IV NCAA Coach of the Year in 1966, Mid-East Regional Coach of the Year in 1968, NCAA College Division Coach of the Year in 1970 and Illinois Coach of the Year in 1976. He is also a member of the Illinois State University Athletic Hall of Fame.

Duffy has been an outstanding contributor to the development of harmonious relationships between college and professional baseball. Although now retired from coaching at Illinois State University, he remains active in baseball as General Manager of the Twin City Stars of the Central Illinois Collegiate League.

BOB BECK - Massac County High School, Metropolis

Bob is truly a career high school baseball coach. In his 27 years as a head coach he was at the helm 5 seasons at Cairo, 2 at Century and the past 20 years at Massac County. His teams have won 386 games, 3 District, 10 Regional and 2 Sectional championships. He has the distinction of having taken teams from two different schools, Cairo and Metropolis, to the Illinois State baseball tournament.

Bob has been well recognized by his peers. In 1981 IHSBCA selected him as area Coach of the Year and in 1982 the Illinois Coaches Association selected him to coach in the All-Star game.





LES CALLAS - Prosser Vocational High School, Chicago

Les has coached at Prosser for the past 20 years. His teams have won 334 games and one City Championship. They have always been competitive in the Northwest Division.

Les has been a leader in the upgrading of the Chicago Public League. He was a founding member of the Public League Coaches Association and served that organization first as Vice President and later as President.

HENRY RICHARD KAISER - Normal Community High School, Normal

Hank coached for 8 years at Greenview, 7 years at McLean-Waynesville and then settled down at Normal Community for the rest of his career. The various teams that he coached accumulated 241 wins.

Hank was also active as a coach in American Legion baseball. He served as President of the Illinois High School Athletic Directors Association and was awarded the District Service Award of the National Interscholastic Administrators Association. Hank retired in 1985 and died of cancer during the past year.





DONALD McALVEY - Thornwood High Schol, South Holland

Don coached 3 years at Thorton Community College and his 1960 Junior College champions went undefeated. Next he moved to Thornridge High School where he began the baseball program, served for 10 years and accumulated 94 victories. His 1970 Thornridge team went 19-1. Enjoying the challenge of starting a new program, he moved on to the brand new Thornwood High School where he served as head coach for another 14 years, winning another 206 games. In total, Don coached 27 years, won 7 League championships, 9 District and 6 Regional titles.

Don is retired from coaching now but continues to teach at Thornwood. His competitive thirst is now quenched by raising thoroughbred horses, trained on his own horse farm.

LARRY PATTON - Belleville East High School, Bellevelle

Larry has been at Belleville as head coach for the past 22 years during which time his teams have won 441 games and 3 Conference championships. In tournament play his record is sensational. His teams have won 4 District, 10 Regional and 6 Sectional titles. He led Belleville East to 3 consecutive State semifinal appearances in 1985, '86 and '87. He was selected St. Louis area Coach of the Year in 1982, 1986 and 1987.

Larry has also been active in the Belleville community. He works with the Little League baseball program and has served as a featured speaker at area clinics. The Fellowship of Christian Athletes often calls on him to speak at various functions around the St. Louis area.


