**FRED SCHMIDT - Leyden High School, Franklin Park**

Fred was the Varsity Baseball Coach at West Leyden High School for 18 years. Before assuming the head baseball job, he was assistant coach at Oak Lawn for 12 years and at West Leyden for 3 years. This makes a total of 33 years coaching high school baseball. At Leyden, Fred's teams won 325 games. They won 5 Conference Championships — 2 in the Des Plaines Valley, 1 in the Northwest Suburban, and 2 in the West Suburban League. Fred's 1974 team finished the regular season undefeated (19-0), but lost the IHSA District Championship game to York High School in 13 innings. Fred was named the 1988 IHSBCA Chicago Area Coach of the year in his final season at Leyden, Fred is retired, but continues to do consulting work for the Leyden School District.

**JIM STUART - Columbia High School, Columbia**

Jim has been the Varsity Baseball Coach at Columbia for 20 years. His teams at Columbia have won 331 games. Before coming to Columbia, Jim coached at high schools in Madison, Missouri; Huntsville, Missouri; and Chester, Illinois. All combined, Jim has coached high school baseball 26 years and his teams have won 396 games. At Columbia, Jim's teams have won 3 Cahokia Conference titles, 2 IHSA District Championships, and 1 IHSA Sectional Championship. In 1987, Jim's Columbia team won the Illinois Class A State Tournament. Jim was voted Coach of the Year in 1987 by the Illinois High School Baseball Coaches Association and Pitch and Hit Club of Chicago. He continues to coach baseball and serve as Athletic Director at Columbia High School.

**DICK CARLEY - Bourbonnais High School, Bradley**

Dick has been the Varsity Baseball Coach at Bradley-Bourbonnais High School for 19 years. Before coming to Bradley-Bourbonnais, he coached at high schools in Cissna Park and Dakota, Illinois. At Bradley-Bourbonnais, Dick's teams have won 361 games. They have won 8 SICA-South Conference Championships, 2 IHSA District, and 2 IHSA Regional Championships. Dick has been named the SICA South Coach of the Year five times. Dick has sent 42 players on to play college baseball. Six of his players have been drafted and five are currently playing professional baseball. Dick continues to coach baseball at Bradley-Bourbonnais.

**CHUCK HASENSTAB - Belleville West High School, Belleville**

Chuck has been the Varsity Baseball Coach at Belleville West High School for the past 24 years. During that time, West has won 378 games. Chuck's teams have won 10 Southwestern Conference Championships, 2 IHSA Regional, and 2 IHSA Sectional Tournaments. In 1973, Chuck guided his team to a second place finish in the IHSA State Tournament. Then again in 1984, he led his team to the State Tournament. Chuck was named the 1988 IHSBCA St. Louis Area Coach of the Year. Chuck is very active in baseball in his area, having been involved in numerous baseball clinics over the years. Chuck continues to coach baseball at Belleville West..

**WALLY SHOTKOWSKI - Thornridge High School, Dolton**

Wally was the Varsity Baseball Coach at Thornridge High School for 20 years. His teams won 384 games. They won 7 SICA East Conference Championships, 5 IHSA Regional Championships, and 1 IHSA Sectional Championship. In 1982, Wally's team got to the semi-finals of the IHSA State Tournament. Wally did internship under Harry Pritikin at Bowen where he assisted him four years. Wally served as president of the SICA Baseball Coaches Association for two years. During his tenure he was responsible for starting the SICA All-Star game. He has run numerous regionals for the summer baseball tournament. Wally retired from baseball after last season but continues to teach at Thornridge where he is the chairperson for Health, Physical Education and Driver's Education..

**GEORGE MCKINNON - Northwestern University, Evanston**

George coached Wildcat baseball for 20 years. Before coming to Northwestern, he coached baseball at Fenn College and Cleveland Heights High School in Ohio. All together he was a head baseball coach for 28 years. At Northwestern his teams won 311. His Wildcat 1970 team was in first place in the Big 10 going into the final week-end of the season. They split games with Minnesota and Wisconsin, giving the title to Minnesota and finishing runner-up. George has had three players that have made it to the Major Leagues — Marty Clary with Braves, Mike Huff, Dodgers; and John Trautwein, Red Sox. George was always a strong supporter of the IHSBCA when he was at N.U. Many people remember that he organized a charter flight to San Francisco for the AABC Convention in 1974. George is retired and lives in Florida..

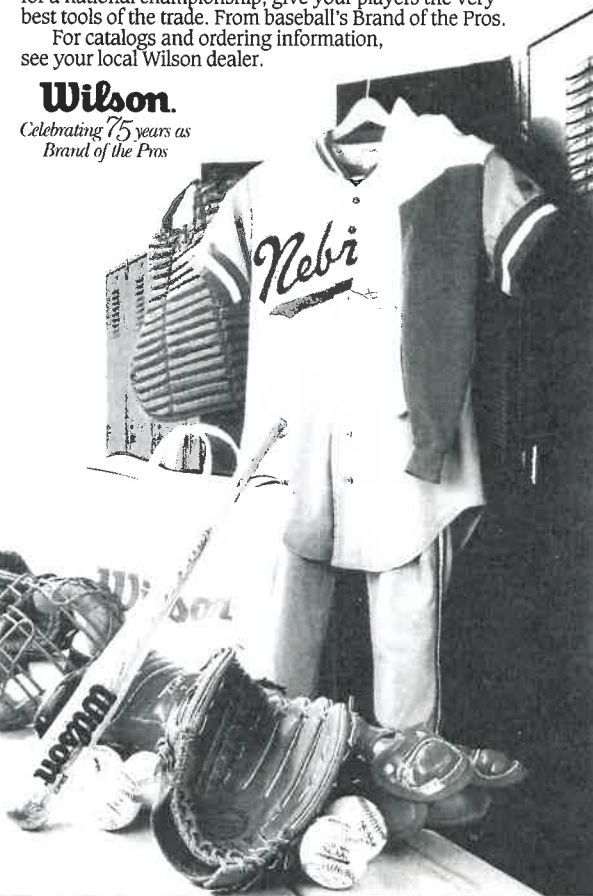
