BOB DALLAS - Gallatin County High School, Ridgway

Bob has been the Varsity Baseball Coach at Gallatin County-Ridgway High School for 34 years. During his tenure his teams have won 365 games. Bob's teams have won 20 Greater Egyptian Conference championships, 2 IHSA District, and 2 IHSA Regional tournaments. He was inducted into the Illinois High School Basketball Coaches Hall of Fame in 1981. His basketball team won the 1973 State Class A Championship. Bob continues to coach both basketball and baseball at Gallatin County High School.

FRANK ECCLES - Thornton Township High School, Harvey

Frank has coached baseball at Thornton for 30 years. He has been the Varsity Baseball Coach for 15 years, having won 207 games. His teams have won 2 IHSA District, 2 IHSA Regional, and 1 IHSA Sectional tournaments. Frank has been very active in the IHSBCA as host for the annual clinic, awards chairman, and presently president. He was inducted into the Thornton High School Hall of Fame in 1977. In 1984 Frank was honored as Man of the Year by the IHSBCA. He has coached international baseball with Team Illinois which toured Australia in the summer of 1989. Frank continues to coach baseball and teach Social Studies at Thornton.



JOHN ENGLERT - Elmwood Park High School

John was the Varsity Baseball Coach at Elmwood Park High School for 22 years. During his tenure, his teams won 328 games. John's teams have won 6 Conference championships in the Tri-County, O'Hare, and Northeast Conferences. They have won 4 IHSA District championships, and 1 IHSA Regional championship. His 1989 team lost in the IHSA Sectional finals to New Trier. John was Varsity Basketball Coach at Elmwood Park for 12 years. He is a TV spotter for the Chicago Bears. He continues to teach at Elmwood Park.

RON GUAGENTI - Rich East, Marian Catholic High School

Ron coached high school varsity baseball 17 years. He coached 12 years at Rich East in Park Forest and 5 years at Marian Catholic in Chicago Heights. His teams won 305 games including 2 IHSA District championships, 5 IHSA Regional championships, and were runners-up twice in IHSA Sectional tournaments. Ron was very active in the IHSBCA, serving as president in 1978-1979, Awards Chairman for 8 years, and Illinois-Michigan All-Star Game Chairman two years. Ron was head coach for the North team in the 1981 Olympic Sports Festival in Syracuse, NY. He coached international baseball two years with Team Chicago going to the Netherlands. Ron retired from high school baseball, but continues to coach the Lansing Sports Angels, an outstanding Connie Mack team.



ED NEIGHBORS - Mt. Zion High School, Mt. Zion

Ed has been the Varsity Baseball Coach at Mt. Zion for 21 years. During his tenure, the Braves have won 387 games, 11 Apollo Conference championships, 1 IHSA District championship, 5 IHSA Regional championships, and 1 IHSA Sectional championship. His teams have won 20 or more games the last ten years in a row. Ed was selected the Decatur Herald Coach of the Year 1980, 83, 86, 88, 90, and IHSBCA East Area Coach of the Year in 1990. Ed continues to coach baseball and golf, and is the Athletic Director at Mt. Zion.

FRANK MARIANI - Holy Cross High School, River Grove

Frank has coached high school varsity baseball for 19 years. He coached 4 years at Notre Dame (Niles), 3 years at St. Viator (Arlington Heights) and 12 years at Holy Cross. The last two years at Holy Cross are after a 15 year retirement. His teams have won 326 games, 9 Suburban Catholic championships, 4 IHSA District championships, 3 IHSA Regional championships, and 1 IHSA Sectional championship going to the State championship in 1965. Frank was a charter member of the IHSBCA. Besides coaching baseball, he was a high school head football coach for 13 years, G.M. for the Chicago Fire, and Chicago Wind professional football teams, and part-owner, G.M. of the Chicago Storm professional softball team. Today Frank coaches baseball at Holy Cross and owns a printing business.


