**RON CHRISTOPHER - Steinmetz High School, Chicago**

Ron has been the varsity coach at Steinmetz for 16 years. His Steinmetz teams have won 246 games, four IHSA District Championships, and one IHSA Regional Championship. Ron's 1975 team was the Chicago Public League Champion. Besides being the varsity coach at Steinmetz, Ron was the head coach at Northeastern Illinois University four years, assistant at Chicago Wells three years, and assistant at Steinmetz four years. These total 27 years of coaching baseball in Illinois. Ron is a past president of the Chicago Public League Baseball Coaches Association and was selected CPLBCA "Coach of the Year" in 1975. Ron was responsible for getting Chicago schools into the summer league in 1989. He continues to coach baseball and teach physical education at Steinmetz.

GENE DA COSSE - Wilson Sporting Goods

Gene played on the 1943 Morton High School Illinois State Championship baseball team. After a three year stint in the Marine Corps, he attended Michigan State University and played baseball one year before an injury cut short his career. DaCosse started work for Wilson Sporting Goods in 1953. This past November he celebrated his 38th year with Wilson. Gene collaborated on creating the Wilson Lefty Gomez Award in 1962 for the ABCA. In 1979 he was honored by the Illinois High School Baseball Coaches and in 1980 was the recipient of the Association's Les Miller "Man of the Year Award." In 1985 Gene was honored by the CPL baseball coaches for meritorious service. He received the ABCA's Honors Award in 1987 and their Meritorious Service Award in 1989. Gene continues to work for Wilson Sporting Goods through which he has been an integral part of the IH clinics and Hall of Fame banquets over the years.

**LARRY JACKSON - Carbondale High School, Carbondale**

Larry has been the varsity baseball coach at Carbondale for the past 19 years. During his tenure, the Terriers have won 221 games, four South Seven Conference Championships, three IHSA District Championships, and five IHSA Regional Championships. He has received the Southern Illinois District "Coach of the Year" award four times. Larry has served on the East-West All-Star Committee for many years. During the summers he has worked in numerous baseball camps throughout the state of Illinois. Larry continues to teach and coach baseball at Carbondale.

MIKE McDONALD - Morton High School, Morton

Mike has been the varsity baseball coach at Morton High School for 15 years. During his tenure, the Potters have won 268 games, three Mid-Illi Conference Championships, three IHSA Regional Championships, one IHSA Sectional, and an IHSA State AA Championship in 1984. Mike has five seasons of twenty or more wins, with a 31-8 record in 1982 being his best. His was 1982 IHSBCA District 3 "Coach of the Year," and 1984 IHSBCA and ICA "Coach of the Year." His list of credits include: Illinois Coaches Association Baseball Chairman four years, being in charge of the East-West All-Star Game, host and clinician for Belgium baseball and softball teams in 1991, color commentary for Sports Channel for the Class AA State Tournament, clinic speaker for the IHSCBCA and University of Missouri, and published articles in "Coaches Digest" and "The Coaching Clinic." Mike continues to teach and coach at Morton.

**RICK MOWEN - Waukegan High School, Waukegan**

Rick has coached varsity baseball for 17 years: one year at Spirit Lake, Iowa, 15 years at Waukegan West, and one year at Waukegan, for a total of 265 wins. Mowen has won three Central Suburban Conference Championships, four IHSA Regional Championships, and one IHSA Sectional Championship. His Raiders of Waukegan West were IHSA AA State Champions in 1983. Rick has served on the IHSA Baseball Advisory Committee. He is the District 4 Baseball Representative for the Illinois Coaches Association. Mowen coached in the ICA East-West All-Star game in 1983. He has had seven players sign professional contracts, including one major leaguer, Jerry Kutzler, with the White Sox. Rick continues to teach and coach baseball at Waukegan.

RANDY ROSE - D.D. Eisenhower High School, Blue Island

Randy has been the varsity baseball coach at Eisenhower for 23 years. During his tenure, his Cardinals have won 327 games, two SICA East Conference Championships, one IHSA District Championship, and One IHSA Regional Championship. Randy is a past president of the SICA Baseball Coaches Association, Conference Representative for the IHSBCA, Sun Times All-Chicago Area Representative, and presently Executive Secretary for the Illinois High School Baseball Coaches Association. Rose has been a clinician at the IHSBCA Clinic and the Chicago Public League Coaches Clinic. Randy was the recipient of the Les Miller "Man of the Year" Award in 1989. He served as a coach for a high school All-Star team that traveled to Australia in 1989 and to Holland and Germany in 1991. Randy continues to teach and coach baseball at Eisenhower

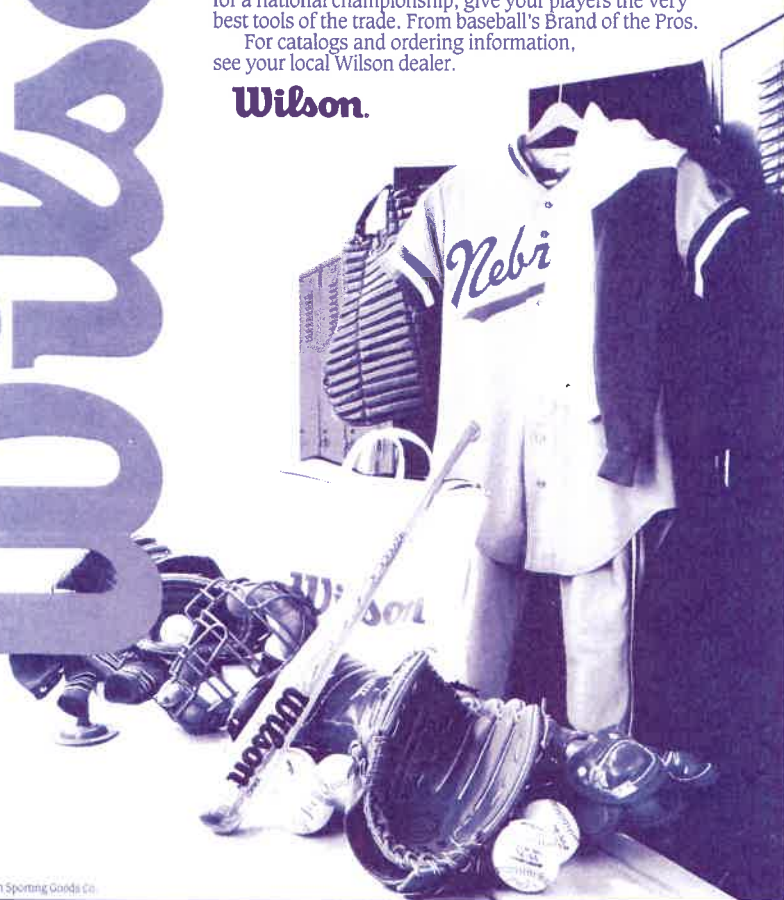
